**Pine Mountain Lake (PML)** – I am still pursuing a Master Plan using FAA Entitlement money.

**Columbia** – Due to security issues being brought to my attention, all of the locks at the Columbia airport have been rekeyed.

This means your key (the change key) still fits the lock. The change is that all of the old master keys floating around out there will no longer work. The airport staff office will maintain the <u>only</u> master keys.
